**No Kid Hungry Summer Meals Texting Program 2017**—No Kid Hungry is proud to promote our summer meals texting hotline, which began in 2013 and is entering its fifth year of operation. This hotline allows children and families to easily and quickly identify open summer meals sites in their area. To receive information about open summer meals sites, users text 'FOOD' to 877-877, and receive a text prompting them to enter an address (either their home address or any other location of their choosing). Once the user replies with a full address and/or zip code, the service provides information about nearby meals sites or information about how to access sites if none are located in the vicinity. Spanish speakers may also access this information by texting 'COMIDA' to 877-877 and receive a response in Spanish.
