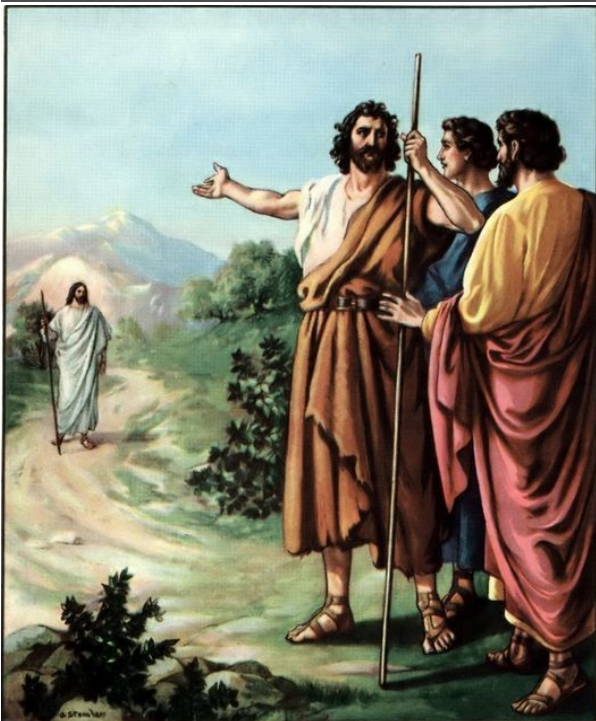

Mass Intentions—If you would like to request a Mass intention, you can fill out a Mass intention envelope at the church or you can create an envelope with the following information: who the Mass intention is for and whether the person is living or deceased, the date you are requesting, your name and a telephone number where you can be reached during the day, and the amount you are offering. You may drop your Mass intention envelope in the collection basket or send it to the office. If the date you request is unavailable, your intention will be scheduled for the next open date available unless you request otherwise.

In accordance with the guidelines from the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston, Mass stipends are deposited in a separate checking account. If you are writing a check, please make it payable to **St. Anthony Mass Account**.

The current suggested level of giving is \$20 for a weekend Mass or \$10 for a daily Mass. Any offering, however, is most welcome, and, if you do not have funds to offer, you are encouraged to request your Mass intention.

St. Anthony Parishioners: THANK YOU!

The Western Regional staff of Catholic Charities WV would like to thank you for your generous contributions to our work in 2017. Because of your monthly contributions to the Western Region, we were able to provide emergency assistance to 169 households and paid a little over \$12,000 toward utility bills in termination or court-ordered evictions. We provided food to 258 unduplicated individuals in Boone and Raleigh Counties, distributing approximately 29,000 pounds of food in 2017. Three hundred and thirteen unduplicated families received personal hygiene and household cleaning products from our pantry in Charleston and Whitesville. The Center for Community Learning and Advancement in Huntington enrolled 94 adult learners working on career and educational goals.

WVIS—Almost Heaven Directed Retreats—The West Virginia Institute for Spirituality located at 1601 Virginia Street East, Charleston, WV 25311 will be offering Almost Heaven Directed Retreats beginning on May 25, 2018 and ending on July 15, 2018. In a directed retreat, it is a silent time in which the retreatant is guided through a prayer experience by a personal spiritual director. If you have never made a directed retreat, the Friday evening through Sunday morning option is a recommended introduction. The cost of the retreat is \$85 per night which includes your room, spiritual direction, materials and all meals. Each meal includes a vegan option. It is \$126 per night for the Hermitage with private bath (handicapped accessible). If you register after May 11, 2018, there is a late fee of \$20.
