God bless you for your kindness to those in need!

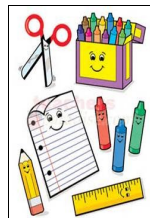
WE NEED YOUR HELP!!!

School supplies will be distributed to children in need in Kanawha, Putnam, Cabell, Mingo, Boone, and Clay counties.

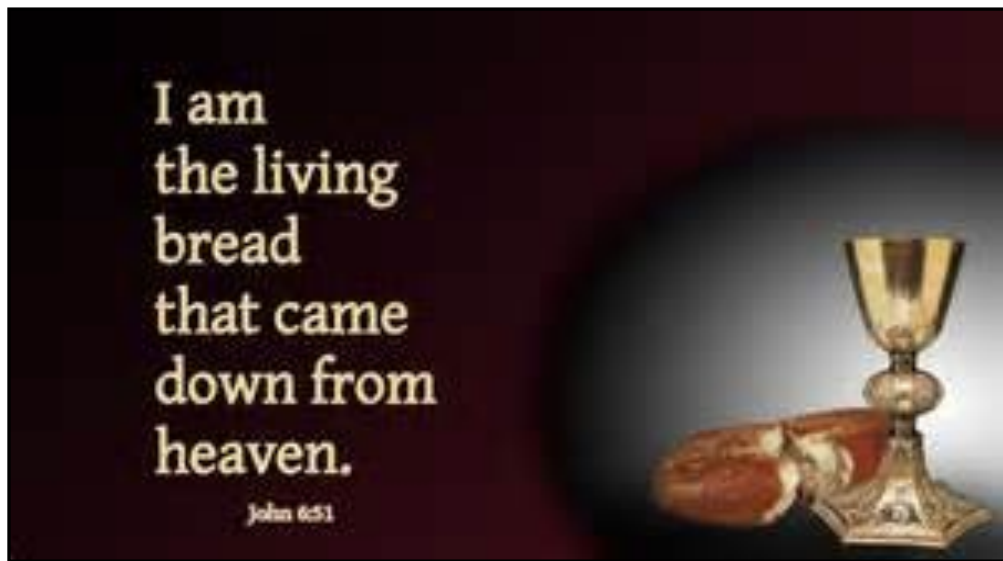

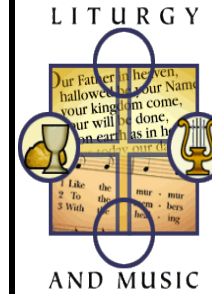
On August 8 & 9, St. Anthony parishioners and friends contributed \$1,729.43.
