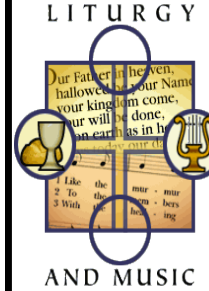


Fish Frydays Profit
