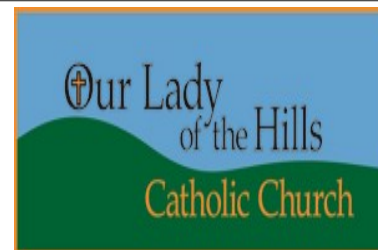

Archdiocese for the Military Services: November 3 & 4—Next weekend we will take up a collection for the Archdiocese of Military Services, USA (AMS). The AMS relies solely on private donors in support of its mission. “Serving those who serve” is the motto for its ministry to provide the same pastoral care and services to Catholics serving in the United States Armed Forces, enrolled in U. S. Military Academies or undergoing treatment at any of the 153 Department of Veterans Affairs’ Medical Centers. AMS supports those working in civilian jobs for the federal government beyond U.S. borders and the families of these populations, as does any other Catholic diocese. While the salaries and retirement of Catholic military chaplains are paid for by the U.S. Government, the AMS receives no funding from the government or the military for its programs and services, including the Co-Sponsored Seminarian Program, which provides priests for home dioceses and for the military chaplaincy. All Souls Remembrance—Each November, we remember our departed loved ones with candles to honor them. If you receive collection envelopes, you may complete the front of the All Souls envelope with the names of your deceased and drop it in the collection basket. If you do not receive envelopes, you may list them on a blank envelope and drop it in the collection basket. The suggested giving level is \$5.00 per candle.

Book of the Names of the Dead—A *Book of the Names of the Dead* has been purchased for each parish and will be placed in the back of the church at St. Anthony and in the gathering space at Our Lady of the Hills. You are invited to record the names of your deceased loved ones for our prayers and remembrance during the month of November. Please enter each name only one time in the book. In the future, you will only need to enter the names of those who have died during the past year. This book is a supplement to our candle remembrance. You will still need to complete and turn in your All Souls envelopes if you wish to remember your deceased with a candle.
