*And after you have served him loyally in his kingdom on earth, may he welcome you to his eternal kingdom in heaven.*



#### Catholic Charities Initiative Status Report—Four Pack of Toilet Tissue

Back by popular demand, we are bringing back our monthly initiative for CCWV by identifying a monthly focus item for collection. Since we are already into February, our first "month" will run through the end of March. This month we have identified four pack of toilet tissue as our focus item for collection. As in the past, we are targeting 100 items as our goal, and we will provide status reports throughout the period. As a reminder, in addition to the four pack of toilet tissue, the other items we have collected in the past include: **canned and package tuna and chicken in water, canned and package soup, Dial bar soap, tooth paste and brushes, disposable razors and shaving cream.** Other items (including hygiene related items) not on the list that you wish to donate are also in great need and greatly appreciated.
