

Note to counters: If there are any **Mass intention envelopes** in the collection, please **do not open** them. Place them aside while you process the collection. When finished with the collection, put the Mass intention envelopes with the collection report for the office. Do not put them in the deposit bag to go to the bank.

MASS INTENTIONS

Mass intentions are offered for many reasons: for example, in thanksgiving for God's graces, for another person (such as on a birthday, anniversary, etc.), for the souls in purgatory, or, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. One should not forget the infinite graces that flow from a Mass that is offered to benefit one's soul. Traditionally, a stipend is given to the priest for offering the Mass which creates an obligation that must be satisfied. The current suggested level of giving is \$20 for a weekend Mass or \$10 for a daily Mass. Any offering, however, is most welcome, and, if you do not have funds to offer, you are encouraged to request your Mass intention.

If you would like to request a Mass intention, you can fill out a Mass intention envelope at the church or you can use a blank envelope from home—be sure to include the following information on the outside of the envelope: who the Mass intention is for and whether the person is living or deceased, the date you are requesting, your name and a telephone number you can be reached at during the day, and the amount you are offering. You may drop your Mass intention envelope in the collection basket or send it to the office. **If the date you request is unavailable, your intention will be scheduled for the next open date available unless you request otherwise.**

In accordance with the guidelines from the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston, Mass stipends are deposited in a separate checking account. If you are writing a check, please make it payable to St. Anthony Mass Account. Reminder: counters please note that Mass intention envelopes are not to be opened when processing the collection. Include any Mass intention envelopes that are in the collection with your collection report to be handled by the office.




LORIE'S MUSIC NOTES
