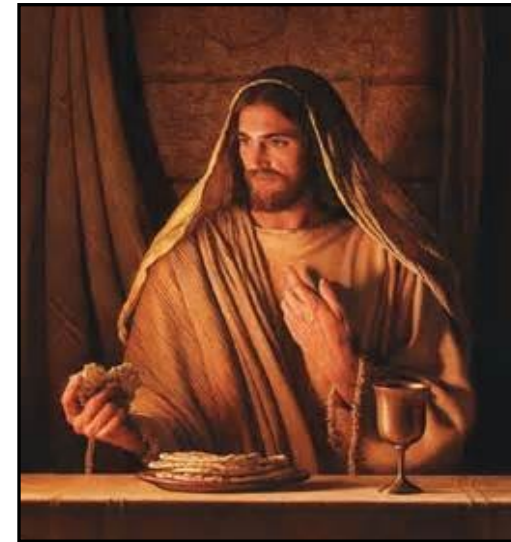
The Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston is sponsoring free workshops for those serving in music ministry in a Parish or Catholic School. Choose a location that is most convenient.

This is called the *epiclesis*.
