World Mission Sunday

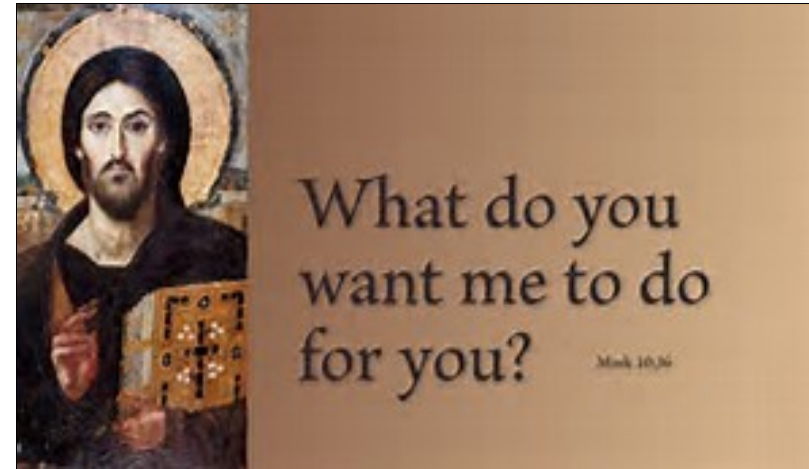

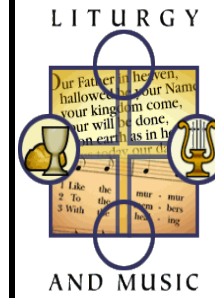
STEWARDSHIP REPORT
