Our Responsorial Psalm today makes a clear connection with the first reading and Gospel. "The fatherless and the widow he sustains" reminds us of the widow who offers the last of her food to Elijah, and then sees it replenished day after day. "...but the way of the wicked he thwarts" points forward to the warning Jesus issues concerning the scribes, who "devour the houses of widows and, as a pretext, recite lengthy prayers." The widow in the Gospel also offers all that she has. Both materially poor and poor in spirit (aware of her dependence on God), she entrusts her life to God. We will sing of the "poor in spirit" in the Communion song today.
