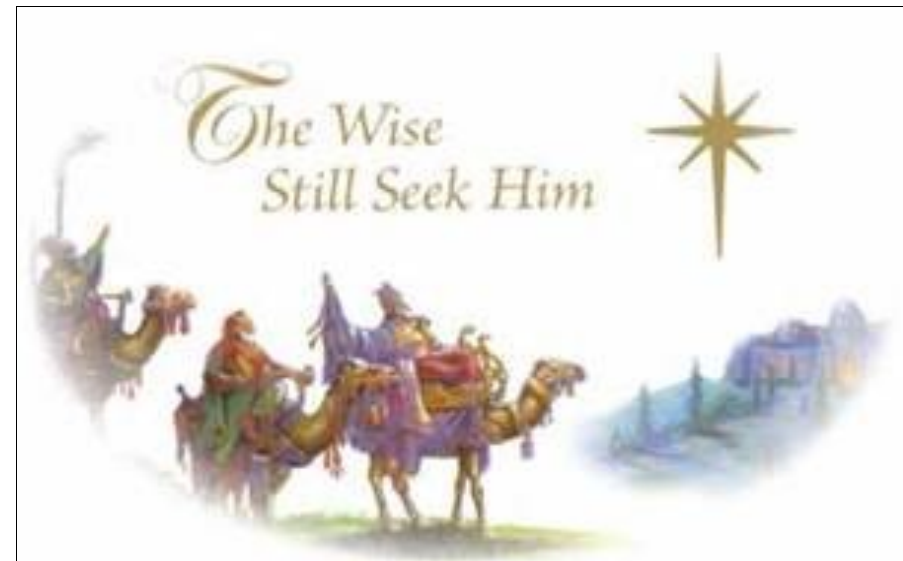
Notes from the Office
