There will be a second collection at the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday Masses for the Education of Seminarians.

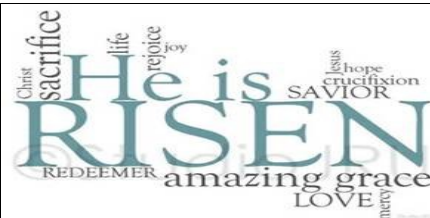
### CCWV Stay at Home Read-A-Thon!
