### Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy

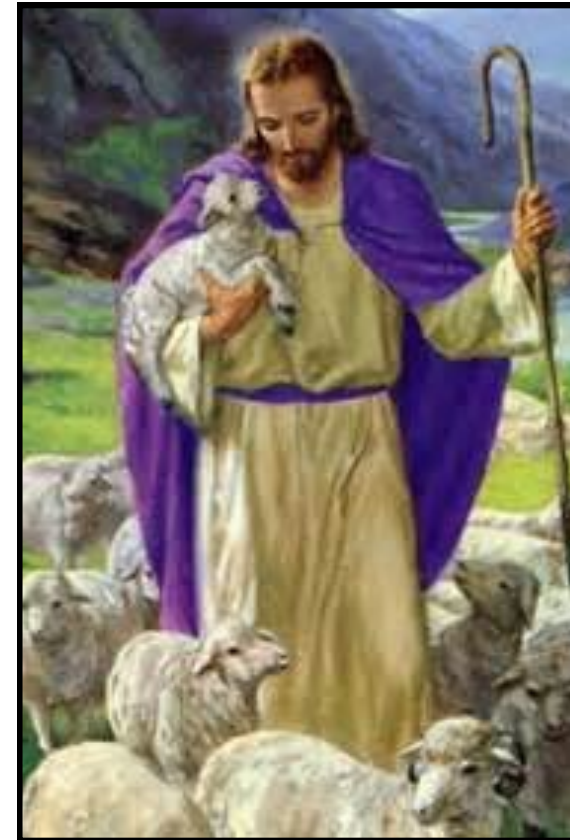
