### **Annual Missionary Appeal**

Next weekend Father Doug May, a Maryknoll Missionary, will speak at all the Masses and give our parishioners the opportunity to spread Christ's message to the unchurched and the Poor overseas. Father Doug, originally from the Buffalo, NY area, has worked in Egypt and the Middle East for 18 years. One of the projects he worked on is a home and school for mentally handicapped children. It has been open since 2004. Father Doug recently returned to the U.S. from Cairo, Egypt where he had been helping to support and accompany the Coptic Catholic priests who were his students over the years when he taught at the Coptic Catholic Seminary in Maadi, Cairo. He also had been writing on current religious and civil events happening in Cairo and providing sacramental and liturgical ministry to Catholic Communities throughout Cairo. Currently, Father Doug is assigned to Maryknoll's Mission Education and Promotion Dept.

While he is here, Father Doug will be happy to talk with any parishioners who are interested in doing overseas mission work as a Maryknoll Priest, Brother of lay Missionary.

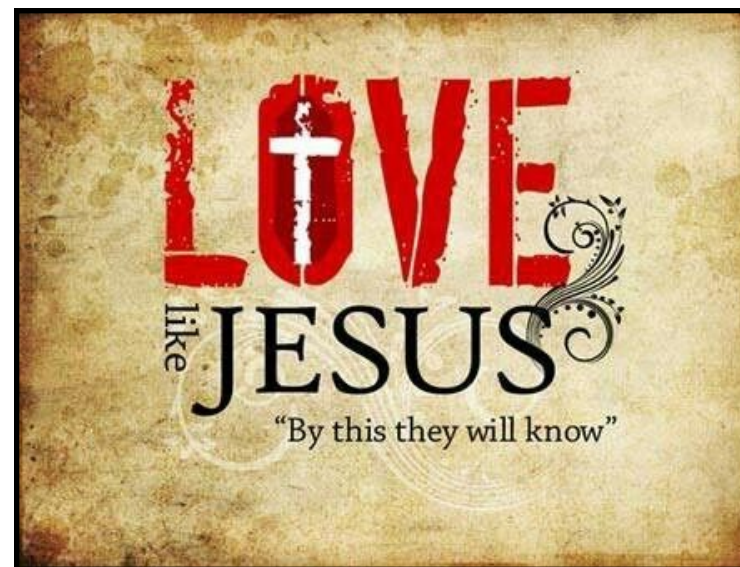
