A Family Perspective by Bud Ozar

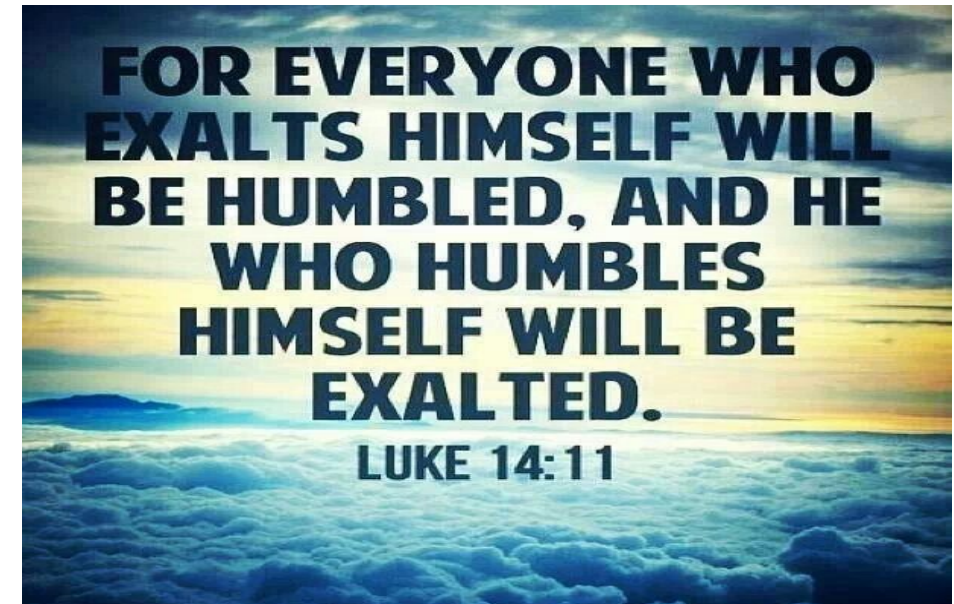
