They all ate and were satisfied, and they picked up the fragments left over—twelve wicker baskets full. Those who ate were about five thousand men, not counting women and children.

### Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Are you interested in becoming a Catholic? Maybe you know someone who might be interested in becoming Catholic. The **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)** which will begin at St. Anthony’s on Monday, September 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM, is the process through which non-baptized adults are prepared to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and the Holy Eucharist at the Easter Vigil (April 4, 2015). The **RCIA** process also welcomes adults who are already baptized but not Catholic and prepares those adults to be received into full communion of the Catholic Church. The **RCIA** also helps those adults baptized Catholic, but who have not received First Communion and/or Confirmation, to complete their sacramental initiation.
